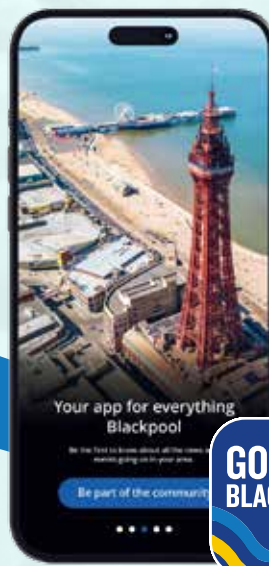

STAYING SAFE

Feeling safe helps you make the most of your student experience. Here you'll find useful contacts and information to help you stay safe, look after yourself and know where to turn if you ever need support.

We want you to enjoy everything Blackpool has to offer with total peace of mind. Local businesses, retail stores, and venues work closely in partnership with Lancashire Constabulary and Blackpool Council through key schemes like Shopwatch and Pubwatch to maintain a safe, welcoming town centre. Venues operate a shared radio network with direct links to the council's CCTV control room and BID Patrol Wardens ensuring swift monitoring and quick support whenever needed.

If you ever feel unsafe or uncomfortable on a night out, you can discreetly "Ask for Angela" at Pubwatch member bars, staff are trained to help get you out of a situation safely.

You can also visit the Safe Space / Safe Haven located at The Place on Clifton Street. Open on Saturday nights, it provides a supportive base run by Street Angels where you can charge your phone, get minor first aid, arrange safe transport, or simply recharge if you get separated from your friends.
